

## PART 7 A

### INFLUENZA VACCINE

For the Winter campaign 2011/12, the payment will be as follows:

Contractors shall submit invoice evidence for supply to PSD, along with prescriptions and stock orders. Payment will be based on:

- Net Ingredient cost at invoice price endorsed on the form
- A fee of £1.10p per vaccine, if the contractor has taken part in risk management practices and has obtained stock from three or more suppliers
- Otherwise a fee of 75p per vaccine
- VAT at the standard rate will be paid on supplies against Stock Order Form GP10A
- If no invoice evidence is supplied, a default price of £3.50p will be paid.

## PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINE

### GP10 (A) Stock Order supply

<b>Product</b>	<b>Price</b>	<b>On-Cost</b>
Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Vaccines	£8.32 + VAT	£1.26
Pneumovax II	£8.32 + VAT	£1.26

- All products to be reimbursed at £8.32. In exceptional circumstances where a stock order has to be honoured wholly or in part with vaccines at a price greater than £8.32, the community pharmacist may endorse that part of the stock order form GP10A with the actual net price and brand name.

### Individually written prescriptions

<b>Product</b>	<b>Price</b>
Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Vaccines	£8.32
Pneumovax II	£8.32

- All products to be reimbursed at £8.32. Where the prescribed vaccine cannot be obtained at £8.32, the GP10 may be endorsed for payment at the manufacturer's list price. The standard dispensing fee shall be paid, unless the pharmacy is subject to transitional reimbursement arrangements for 2010-11.
